

## CHANGES IN THE CONGREGATION'S PRAYERS AND RESPONSES AS OF FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT, NOVEMBER 27, 2011

*(See OCP missal for the Gloria and Creed. Changes are noted in boldface)*

*At the Greeting and in other dialogues during the Liturgy, whenever the priest says, "The Lord be with you" or equivalent words, the congregation now responds:*

**And with your spirit.**

### **Penitential Act A:**

I confess to Almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have **greatly** sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, **through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore** I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

### **Penitential Act B:**

Priest: **Have mercy on us, O Lord.**

People: **For we have sinned against you.**

Priest: **Show us, O Lord, your mercy.**

People: And grant us your salvation.

### **Gospel:**

Priest: A reading from the holy Gospel according to N.

People: Glory to you, O Lord.

### **Preparation of the gifts:**

Priest: Pray, brethren...

People: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good, and the good of all his **holy** Church.

### **The Eucharistic Prayer:**

Priest: The Lord be with you.

People: **And with your spirit.**

Priest: Lift up your hearts.

People: We lift them up to the Lord.

Priest: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People: **It is right and just**

All: Holy, holy, holy Lord God of **hosts** *(continue as previously)*

### **Acclamations:**

Priest: **The mystery of faith.**

People:

A: **We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again.**

OR B: When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your death, **O Lord,** until you come **again.**

OR C: **Save us, Savior of the world, for** by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.

### **Communion:**

Priest: **Behold** the Lamb of God, **behold him** who takes away the sins of the world. **Blessed** are those **called to the supper of the Lamb.**

People: Lord, I am not worthy **that you should enter under my roof,** but only say the word and **my soul** shall be healed.
